This position reports directly to the owner(s) and CEO(s) of Edensaw Woods, Ltd. and Kiwiandco LLC, providing a variety of financial statements and reports on business sales and revenue on a daily and weekly basis. This is a great opportunity for an experienced accountant to join a close-knit, family-owned and operated company.
